Question 2 Describe the physiological consequences of prolonged hypovolemic shock Answer 2 If untreated hypovolemic shock can lead to multiorgan failure Reduced tissue perfusion due to inadequate blood flow leads to cellular hypoxia and ischemia This can damage vital organs like the kidneys acute kidney injury the brain encephalopathy and the heart myocardial dysfunction Metabolic acidosis can develop due to anaerobic metabolism
